Recreational Vehicle Permit Application

The recreational vehicle permit is available for 24 hour intervals of up to five (5) days out of every month for **City residents or their guest.** The five (5) days can be used consecutively or non-consecutively. **The hosting resident or resident RV owner must apply for a permit.** Code Compliance staff may request evidence of residency within the City. A resident may apply for the permit no less than five (5) business days before the permit is needed. Approval of RV Parking permits is at the discretion of Code Compliance staff. RV owners and permit applicants may be subject to enforcement for non-compliance. Please email this form to CodeCompliance@cosb.org, or deliver to City Hall. Requirements [SBMC Sections 10.28.200, 10.28.205, 10.28.210, 15.24.060]:

- Recreational vehicles must be parked within 300 feet of the resident's home indicated above.
- Recreational vehicles must park at least 50 from an intersection.
- You must display the permit on the dashboard of the passenger side so it can be seen through the windshield.
- Boats, boat trailers or recreational trailers may not be stored or parked on the city street or within a city parking lot for more than two (2) hours, daily.
- Camping within or occupying a RV is not allowed.
- Overnight parking in City parking lots is prohibited (where signs are posted).
- No electrical cords or hoses may cross over or obstruct any sidewalk or street.
- Extended "Pop-outs", "slide-outs", shade covers or other obstructions are prohibited on City property.
- RV license plates shall be visible and the RV shall not create a hazard.
- RV shall comply with all parking regulations.
