1. Call To Order And Roll Call:

2. Oral Communications - Public:

5. HDL - Sales Tax & Measure S Update (4th Quarter 2024)

David Mcpherson from HDL presented the 4th quarter sales tax and Measure S reports. He started by presenting sales tax data and trends across Southern California as a whole, as well as San Diego County and within different industries and geographic regions of Solana Beach. He reviewed the quarterly newsletter which discussed the highlights for the City, including changes for both sales tax & Measure S Tax compared to prior years and the Top 25 Producers. He finished by discussing gap comparison tables and answered questions from the commissioners.

6. FY 2026 & FY 2027 Proposed Budget

Finance Director Rachel Jacobs presented the FY 2026 & FY 2027 proposed budget. Director Jacobs presented on the General Fund and the Measure S Fund with expected surpluses in both funds for each of the budgeted years. Expenditures using Measure S funds were then broken down even further. After going through the Internal Service Funds and the Sanitation Fund, Director Jacobs presented several slides showing the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) projects for fiscal years 2026 and 2027, as well as the five-year CIP. She then discussed the proposed change to the General Fund Reserve Policy that would also be adopted along with the budget. Finally, she presented the commission with the next steps which is their memo to Council. Director Jacobs answered questions from the commissioners.

7. FY 2026 Investment Policy

Finance Director Rachel Jacobs pulled up the City's investment policy and asked the commissioners if they had any questions or comments. She answered a few questions. The commissioners were okay with the policy as-is.
