### 7. CLIMATE ACTION PLAN & SUBCOMMITTEE UPDATES

 Decarbonize Electricity Supply – Commissioners Basore, McClune, Flagg & Crocker

Subcommittee members discussed three strategies to decarbonize electricity supply. Commissioner Flagg discussed promoting the growth of rooftop solar. Chairperson McClune discussed energy storage capacity.

 Decarbonize Buildings – Commissioners Dewar, McClune, Sharman & Councilmember Zito

Chairperson McClune discussed decarbonization strategies including getting more residents on the 100% renewable plan through the CEA, and City incentives for appliances such as electric water heaters.

• **Decarbonize Transportation** – Commissioners Nagamine & Rock

Vice Chairperson Nagamine provided an update regarding access to and maintenance of EV charging stations in the City. Commissioners and Staff discussed balancing multifamily residential parking demands and the availability of EV charging stations. Mr. King noted that the City receives 40% of the revenue made from the EV charging stations in the City Hall parking lot, which covers the electricity cost.
