David Ott, City Manager, introduced the item. He stated that over a year ago the Del Mar Fairgrounds introduced a Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR), that the City had reviewed the 1,700 page document within ten days and provided 550 comments to the 22nd District Agricultural Association, that a meeting regarding the responses to the City was scheduled, that a letter would be sent stating that ten days was not adequate time to review the comments and to request that the upcoming meeting be postponed and changed to after-work hours so that the public could participate.

Council and City Manager discussed that the methodology used to respond to comments was confusing and not user-friendly, that there was not a good faith effort to respond to the community concerns, and that the 22nd District Agricultural Association Board should have met with the City, as required by CEQA, since the City provided direct first responder services for the area. He said that the proposed letter should be sent from the Mayor to the Executive Director of the Board of the 22nd District Agricultural Association and that the Council wanted to be informed of the City's legal options.
